**Jill McNeese:** "Sitting on the mountaintop at Herod's Palace looking down on the Promised Land of milk and honey."

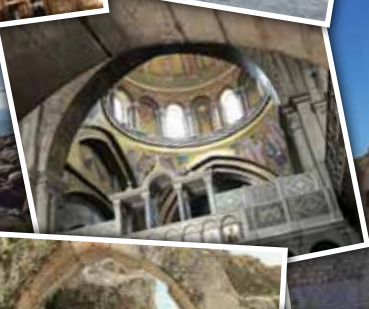

*Hello, dear friends!* I'm writing this to you as I'm flying approximately 37,000 feet over the North Atlantic Ocean. It's incredible to think that tomorrow I'll be joining 12 others from Wesley, plus 3 of their family and friends,

as we start our journey through the Holy Land! This once-in-a-lifetime pilgrimage has been planned for over a year now, and my fellow pilgrims and I couldn't be more excited to visit sites like the Church of the Nativity, Jacob's Well, the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, and many others.

Another location we'll visit is the Garden Tomb in Jerusalem. While scholars debate the legitimacy of this site, I have heard that many pilgrims find this place particularly special. You see, the skull-shaped rock formation adjacent to the property has led many to believe that it was in this place that Jesus sacrificed His life and then rose victoriously over sin and grave, the place where He became 'Christus Victor' for our sake. ## Easter Greetings from Pastor Sara

A kindergarten class was once shown a dandelion and asked why they thought a dandelion might be a good symbol for Easter. One child said, "the dandelion is bright and beautiful, like Jesus!" Another child answered, "dandelion seeds blow around everywhere and bloom where you don't expect them, just like the Holy Spirit!" There were parent volunteers in the room that day, and one of them whispered to the other, "Dandelions are just like Jesus – we try and try to kill them, but they just keep coming back!"

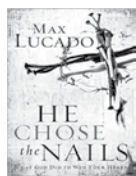

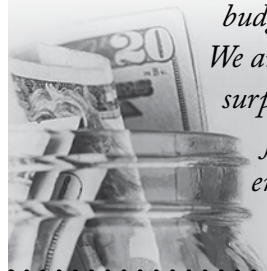
