a Note From from our Pastors

Last month, the news out of Riverside, CA that pastor and mental health advocate Jarrid Wilson had died by suicide both caught our attention and brought sadness to our hearts. Have you ever sat in the pit of despair? Perhaps you're one who knows more than most just how deep it can be. There are times that it can be hard for even the most jovial among us to see light shining down to where they sit. Thoughts of inadequacy, failure, anger, jealousy, sorrow, etc. bring about depression in millions of people each year. And sometimes being in the pit can even make us think about causing harm to ourselves. If you or someone you love has ever been deep in the pit of despair, we want to share with you a few things that our colleague Adam Hamilton recently shared with his congregation:

You are loved by, and matter to, God.

2) There is always hope.

3) Others can help.

October 10, is World Mental Health Day (see below for more details), and this year the goal is to raise awareness for suicide prevention. We want to do the same. Please know, if you or someone you love has ever had thoughts about suicide, Wesley UMC is a place where you will find no judgment. We want to help however we can.
